Information recorded:

- Street name and house number in some cities
- Name, Age, Race, and Gender of individuals in a household
- Relationship of each individual to head of household
- Single, Married, Widowed, or Divorced
- Length of Marriage
- Number of Children born and Living
- Professional Status / Title
- Length of Unemployment
- Employee, Employer, or self-employed
- Place of Birth
- Place of Parents Birth
- Survivor of the Union or Confederate Army / Navy
- Year of Immigration
- Length of Residence in the United States
- Whether he/she has been naturalized
- Illness &/or Disability
- Blind, Deaf, Dumb, Idiotic, Insane, Maimed, Crippled, or Bedridden
- School Attendance (only in the year of the census)
- Literate and able to write
- Able to Speak English
- Is the residence rented or owned, mortgaged or not, farm or house
